REGULAR DECISION APPLICATION NUMBERS

James Madison University is experiencing a historic increase in applications from the Class of 2028. Regular Decision application decisions were posted by JMU's Office of Admissions on Wednesday, March 6.

JMU received 40,232 total undergraduate applications for this admissions cycle, a 7% increase from last year and a 25% increase from 2022. This year's mark is a remarkable 78% higher compared to 2021. We received applications from 50 states, US territories, and 92 other countries.

20,733 of our applicants are from Virginia, while 18,142 are applying from out-of-state. More information can be found here.
