

BFA checklist graphic design

The Graphic Design BFA degree requirements have changed for the 2015-2016 catalog year. These changes will NOT impact your degree progress if you choose to stay in the catalog year that you entered under (meaning do nothing). If you would like to opt for this new degree program you must change your degree catalog year to 2015-2016. If you choose to make this change you **MAY NOT** go back to your original catalog year. To change your catalog year you must complete a "Request to Change Academic Plan (Catalog) Requirement Year" form. This form must be filled out, signed by your major advisor and then signed by the SADAH School Director in the SADAH Office (Duke RM 1011). After you must take the signed form to the Registrar's office. Be sure to have your student ID with you. If you would like additional information please contact your advisor or Trudy L. Cole, Coordinator of Graphic Design.

The Graphic Design Major requires 78 credit hours in art, art history and art-related courses. Of these hours, 30 must be in graphic design courses.
