The successful candidate will have a strong background in general computer science along with a commitment to providing excellence in teaching and research. Preference will be given to applicants who can provide high quality teaching at the undergraduate level including the potential to develop an active, undergraduate-oriented research program. The department is also interested in applicants that can extend or expand its activities in one or more areas, including but not limited to multimedia, computer gaming, web systems, cloud computing, cyber-forensics and information security. The department welcomes applicants with an interest in teaching online. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to teach in the graduate programs as well, depending on qualifications and interest. A Ph.D. in Computer Science or related field at the time of employment is preferred.
