

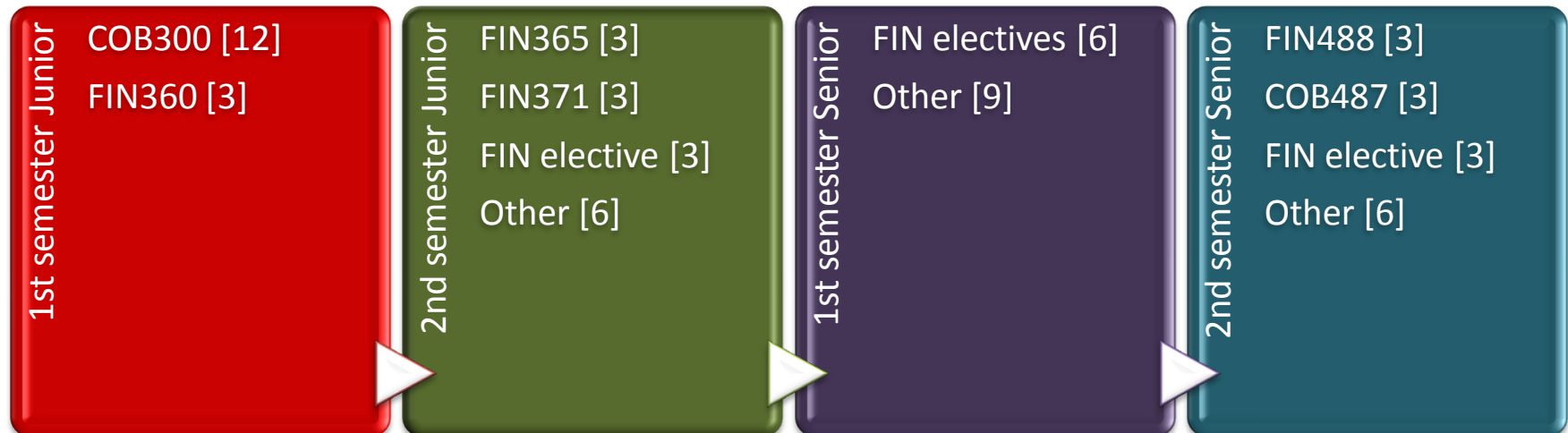
# Typical progression for a student majoring in Finance

- A student may not take more than 9 credit hours of FIN-prefix courses in one semester.

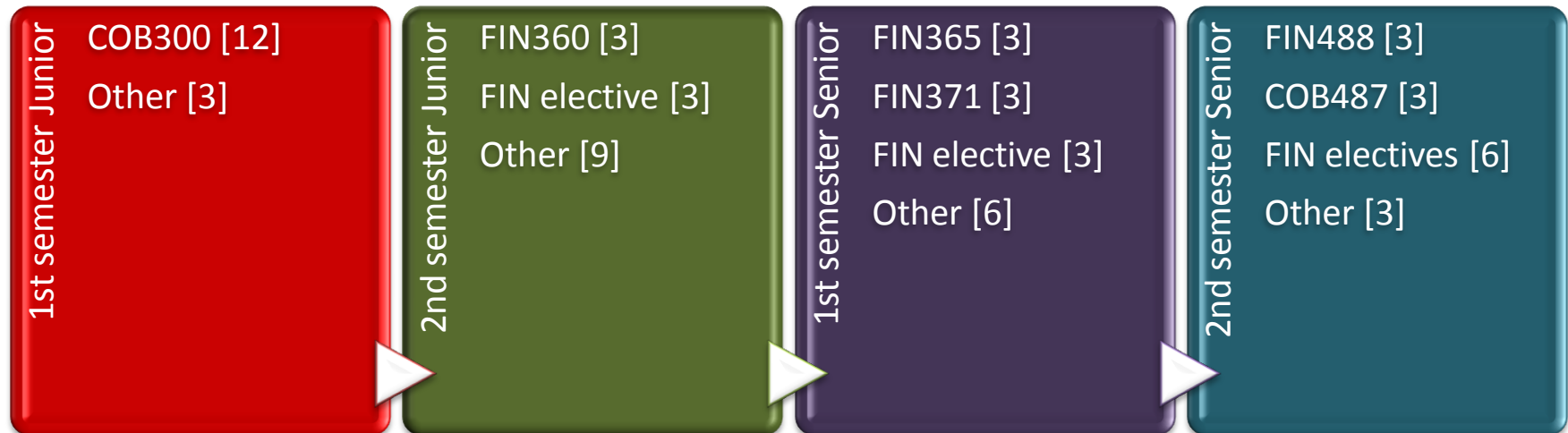
