

Specific Area Endorsement Requirements

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

French, German, Italian, Spanish

Foreign Language Endorsement Requirements: To be licensed to teach preK-12 Foreign Language, the candidate must satisfactorily complete requirements for a baccalaureate degree to include the following **Foreign Language Courses** or their **approved** equivalents. Grade requirements for teacher licensure are different than grade requirements for the major. Teacher Licensure candidates must receive grades of "C-" or higher in the coursework listed below.

Course Type	Credits
Conversation, composition, phonetics, and grammar beyond the elementary level	15-18
Culture and civilization	3-6
Literature	6-9
Total Endorsement Credits (Candidate must complete 30 credit hours of foreign language course work <u>above</u> the intermediate level)	36
Endorsement in a Second Foreign Language	
Course Type	Credits
For a second endorsement in a modern foreign language (with licensure in another modern foreign language), the student must complete 24 semester hours of course work above the intermediate level in the second language	24
