Items below can also be placed in a deskside bin.

RECYCLE: PLASTIC, CANS & GLASS

Rinse food containers.

- glass bottles & jars of any color
- plastic bottles & caps
- plastic cups (no compostable or foam cups)
- plastic containers (#1 through #6)
- plastic lids
- plastic bags
- sandwich/storage bags
- bubble wrap
- metal cans
- *no Items labeled with #7 PLA

RECYCLE: PAPER

- white printer & copier paper
- colored paper
- sticky notes
- envelopes
- newspapers
- magazines
- catalogs
- paperboard cartons (e.g., cereal boxes & boxed lunch cartons) with no food/food residue
- flat corrugated boxes in small amounts (e.g., flat pizza boxes with no food/food residue)

<u>E-CYCLE: ELECTRONICS, BATTERIES</u> <u>& CARTRIDGES</u>

Enclose the following in a paper bag, a plastic bag or the original box before placing in a container:

- ink & toner cartridges
- adapters, chargers, cables & cords
- portable electronic devices
- batteries

COMPOST

Place these items in containers labeled "compost" at campus dining locations:

- food
- napkins & paper towels
- pizza & other boxes with food residue
- compostable items from Dining Services only (not from other vendors): hot cups · Pepsi cups and lids · straws · compostable clamshells · compostable utensils · sushi containers and lids · items labeled with #7 PLA

TRASH/LANDFILL

Place the following in containers labeled "landfill":

- chip bags
- candy & snack bar wrappers
- condiment packets
- milk & soy cartons
- used tissues
- "foam" cups and hot cups
- food & compostable items (when unable to carry to containers labeled "compost")

SPECIAL SERVICES

Call JMU Recycling/Waste Management 540-568-6074 to assist with the following:

- wood & wood products
- confidential paper (to be shredded)
- large electronics & appliances
- metal & wire

JMU property should be sent to Surplus Property.

- Food, liquid and trash contaminate the recycling. When some recycling items are contaminated, none of the items in the container can be recycled.
