

## Motion on Transfer of Vision Funds

### Faculty Senate of James Madison University

March 26, 2015

Whereas the President of James Madison University committed \$10,000 to the Faculty Senate to use in furthering the University Vision, and

Whereas the Faculty Senate passed the Madison Vision Teaching Award Resolution on January 29, 2015, which committed \$3,000 of the aforementioned \$10,000 these teaching awards (a \$1,000 prize for each of the three winners), and

Whereas the Faculty Senate also passed the Motion to Create Vision Mini-Grants on January 29, 2015, which allocated the remaining money to award mini-grants to the most worthy proposals, and

Whereas it has been determined that the Madison Vision Teaching Awards will not be ready to be up and running during the 2014-15 year, and

Whereas the mini-grant application process has produced an exceptionally promising pool of proposals in terms of quality and quantity, now therefore be it

Resolved that, only for the 2014-15 academic year, the Faculty Senate approves the transfer of the \$3,000 allocated to the Vision Teaching Award to be used to fund additional mini-grants pursuant to the Motion to Create Vision Mini-Grants.
