Program/Concentration Changes

Students who wish to change their program of study or concentration must submit a *written* request to The Graduate School. Paperwork is then faxed to the department for approval and returned to The Graduate School in campus mail with original signatures. Since the program of study and the concentration appear on the student's transcript when the degree is posted, it is imperative that the correct information is in the student's database. Change of program/concentration requests should be submitted to The Graduate School promptly when the student makes the request, not when the student applies to graduate.

Concentrations can be viewed by the adviser in the Student Center in e-Campus. Please contact The Graduate School if you have any questions.

Reminder: Thesis/Dissertation!

Students completing a thesis or dissertation will submit their documents electronically to the JMU libraries. Students are also required to submit two copies of their approval pages to TGS. The approval pages should be signed in black ink. We hope this will serve as a more convenient method of submitting thesis and dissertations, as well as save on printing and expenses.
