## I. Approval of the Minutes

Upon motion by Dani Bronaugh, seconded by Hossain Heydari, the Graduate Council unanimously approved the May 18, 2018, Graduate Council Retreat minutes.

### II. Announcements, Reports, and Updates

- 1. Dr. Chen introduced the Interim Associate Dean for Student Services, John Burgess. He described his role and responsibilities for the Graduate School (TGS) and everyone was encouraged to contact him if they have any questions or concerns.
- 2. Dr. Chen announced, as of Monday, the fall graduate enrollment has 1,800 graduate students enrolled. This is almost as high last year's record high census date enrollment of 1,861. Michael Stoloff explained that enrollment may continue to grow between now and the census date. JMU has a remarkably strong enrollment this year given that that there was no new programs, and several programs are either not accepting applications or will not operate this year due to low number of applications.
- 3. Michael Stoloff addressed an inquiry from the Graduate Council regarding the impact on enrollment of the Governor's directive to prepare teachers with 4-year undergraduate teacher education programs. Jie and Michael are actively participating in a task force that is encouraging the development of new teacher education curricula that is consistent with this directive. It is expected that JMU may develop some new graduate programs that will support teachers who enter the classroom after only 4-years of preparation. Next year graduate enrollment may not see any changes because of these developments, but will eventually lose approximately 300 graduate students when the 5<sup>th</sup>-year programs close unless new continuing education opportunities are implemented and many students enroll.
- 4. Michael Stoloff introduced Brooke Graham, a graduate student enrolled in the Strategic Leadership Program. Among her projects, Brooke will continue to work with Program Directors to improve the campus-wide email marketing strategy started last year.
- 5. Michael announced the Holistic Review Lecture and Workshops and highlighted that the workshops will address concerns expressed by program directors after the drop of the university-level national test requirement for graduate admission. The lecture and workshops will help attendees consider new methodologies to select graduate students, which can be used with or instead of standardized tests.
- 6. Michael announced TGS is further automating admissions using CollegeNET Admit. He explained how the system would enable remote access to application materials, facilitate application review by multiple faculties, and allow programs to communicate admission recommendations to TGS. CollegeNET Admit testing with selected programs will begin during the fall 2018 semester and hope to make the program available to all programs by summer 2019.
- 7. The Curriculum Dates & Deadlines have been posted on our graduate school website. Next week, expect an e-vote on a few courses that are ready for Graduate Council review.
- 8. John Burgess highlighted the Student Services dates and deadlines announcements which included Travel Grants, Scholarships, and the 3MT competition.
- 9. John explained how TGS is reviewing <u>The Graduate Policies & Procedures Manual</u>. They plan to have the document combined with the <u>Graduate Catalog</u>. All revisions will be presented to GC for final approval. Student Services is also coordinating with the Research Assistant Program to facilitate more RA positions; all Programs are encouraged to submit proposals via <u>burgesjg@jmu.edu</u>.

10. Dr. Chen introduced the graduate council student representatives Jack Nichting and Jackson Chambers who are also president and vice president of the Graduate Student Association (GSA). They highlighted announcements such as GSA events, <u>Facebook profile</u>, and a request to have graduate program directors encourage students to participate in GSA.
