- 90 work hours (10 weeks)
- Sport- or recreation-focused
- With other classes
- Typically Fall or Spring
- Academic work included
- Prereq: SRM 241

INTERNSHIP

- 6-credit CR/NC course
- 400 hours (10 weeks)
- Sport- or recreation-focused
- 0 or 1 other class
- Typically Summer
- Academic work included
- Prereq: SRM 282, SRM 333, 72 hours, not on academic probation
