Look for information in Canvas. Tickets not required for graduates.



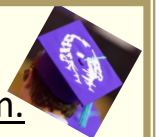

- Shuttles will run from 2:00 pm until 3:00 pm from the Festival Loop to Bridgeforth Stadium for the University Ceremony.



## Medallion Ceremony Event Timeline

# 11:00-11:45 am

All students (& guests) arrive at the Festival Ballroom wearing regalia **WITHOUT** the mortar board. Pick up your name card at the information desk and enter the ballroom to find a seat in the graduate seating. Guests will sit in appropriate guest seating area. Ushers will be available to assist.



# 12:00-1:30 pm



All graduates will cross the stage and the Honors College Medallion will be conferred upon them by Dean Newcomer. Grad Images will be taking a photo of students on stage and again as they exit the stage. Please follow the usher instructions.

# 1:30-2:00 pm

Once medallions are conferred Dean Newcomer will request students stay in their seats for a group photo. All guests are then welcome to mingle, take photos and enjoy refreshments while visiting with the Honors College team.
