

# Study Abroad and Honors

The Honors Program strongly encourages and supports study abroad by its students in a variety of ways. Registration for honors students studying abroad is handled through the Office of International Programs.

**Honors Seminars Abroad.** In May 2010, the Honors Program launched a six-credit May term honors course in London. It included a spring term preparatory component, the May term London experiential component, and a fall term symposium. In 2011, the Honors Program offered two honors seminars abroad: one in London and one in Florence. Information about future offerings will be posted on this website.

**Oxford Honors.** The Oxford Honors program is not administered by the Honors Program, but it has a special arrangement with the Program. Students who participate in the Honors Abroad Program to Oxford, Cambridge, and St. Andrews Universities in Great Britain can earn up to 12 honors credits for their experience.

**Other Study Abroad.** Students in the Honors Program considering Study Abroad should consult with one of the Program directors to learn more about coordinating study abroad and Honors Program requirements. Students may arrange Honors Option elective credit for an independent study based on their study abroad.

All students participating in any program that requires them to be off-campus for a semester or academic year are required to notify the Honors Program one semester prior to leaving.
