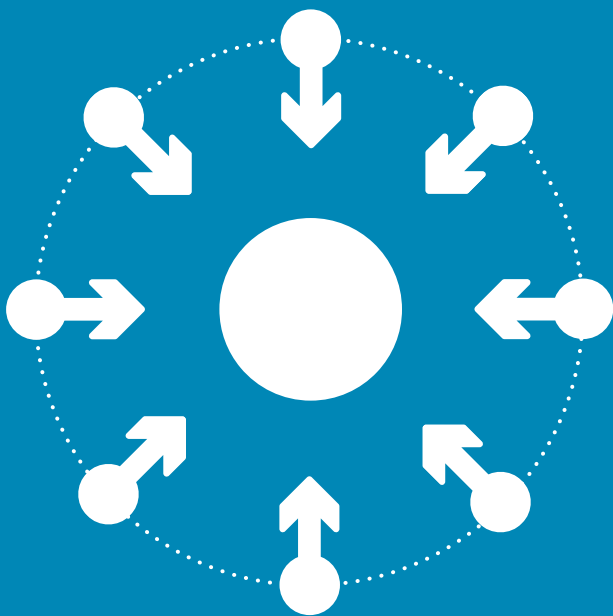

VISUALIZING WORLDWIDE CONTAINER MOVEMENT USING GIS SIMULATION

PROF. HELMUT KRAENZLE

With millions of shipping containers traveling toward US ports annually, ensuring the safety of the country is a high priority. The Geographic Information System for Simulating Container Movement (GISSCM) is a simulation program that tracks the movement of containers traveling toward the US via ship. Once entering the port, the GISSCM continues tracking each container as it travels via train or truck to its destination. The location and movement is simulated using a computer program.
