Education in Costa Rica: Literacy and Curriculum in a Global Community

PROGRAM:

Students will complete a required education course as well as an elective to strengthen student skill sets in working with English Language Learners. Students will experience teaching and learning with local Costa Rican students. Host families will provide a rich cultural experience as students live and share meals with local families. The program will be divided into two phases. The first phase consists of three weeks taking courses at the University of Peace as well as focusing on cultural assimilation. The second phase will consist of project-based learning in a rural school implementing service projects developed in the first phase.
