## Learning Outcomes

- Student will view hall staff as resource person first and foremost
- Students will develop perceived cohesion to this hall and the larger JMU community\*
  - Help residents make connection to campus and community involvement
  - Increase awareness of substance use issues and alternative weekend activities
- Students will develop a value of civic engagement
  - Increase awareness of community advisory board elections and leadership opportunities within the hall
  - Increase awareness of issue of sustainability
- Students will mature in their academic values and behaviors
  - Increase awareness of academic and career resources on campus

## Community Development Model

1. Pre-req program requirements completed by RAs and HD
  - Hall-Wide social
    - a. Fall Semester - 2 programs
      - i. One within the first month (fall)
    - b. Spring Semester- 1 program
    - c. One on a weekend
  - Safety & Security
  - Alcohol/Drug Education (with PAs)
  - Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention
  - Got Housing: OCL program about moving off
2. Individual meetings with each resident face to face for a minimum of 30 minutes (1 in Fall semester plus any new residents throughout the year) plus any follow up needed (1 email following initial contact).

Please note: fabrication of data can lead to termination from RA role.

Follow up emails, facebook, print outs

It is critical to have an email address from each of your residents that they regularly check. These emails are intended to continue the personal contact you made with him/her during the face to face conversation. Follow ups should occur within one month of the original conversation. This gives you an opportunity to respond to any questions the student had during that meeting

that you did not know the answer. This gives you time to research the answers for them. Include the answer in the follow up email that way you can help meet that individual students needs. ALL EMAILS MUST BE BCC TO YOUR SUPERVISOR.

3. CE Programs hosted through CAP to be announce in early fall. These programs will be hosted by area (i.e., conversation on diversity). RAs from the area will need to work together to coordinate advertising and food for the event.
4. CAP programs listed above plus Fall open house hosted/coordinated by HD
  - a. Fall
    - i. CAP Open House (Oct) {Staff Devo}
5. In the fall, a minimum of 2 Community programs per floor. These will be done by section/floor.  
In the spring, minimum of 3 community programs. These programs can be open to any residents in the building. Only one RA will receive credit unless pre-determined by area director.
