**NPI Scholarships**

The Non-Profit Institute's Certificate in Non-Profit Management offers professional development for area non-profit leaders. The program includes 38 total hours of professional development over seven months for a cost of \$350; all registration fees cover the cost of offering the program.

The steering committee recognizes, however, that not all non-profit organizations share the same resources, and that the financial commitment for this program may cause hardship for some potential participants. Therefore, a limited number of partial scholarship funds are available, and will be awarded on a case-by-case basis.

To apply for scholarship funds, please submit statement (no longer than one page), including participant name, organization, and amount of scholarship funds requested.

Statement should address the following:

1. Describe how this program would help shape your professional career.
2. Describe how this program would help you improve as a leader in your organization.
3. Describe the financial need of your organization in regards to professional development, and provide contact information for at least one other person at your organization who can verify that need.

Scholarship applications must be submitted by September 8, 2010. To submit application, send statement via e-mail attachment to: [outreach@jmu.edu](mailto:outreach@jmu.edu).
