OFFENSE: On Campus Assault
LOCATION: Duke Dr. Area
TIME: 10:30pm on April 9, 2010
SUSPECT(S): One of the suspects is described a tall thin Hispanic or African American female wearing a black jacket and jeans

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal *Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998* the James Madison University Police Department is giving notice of a incident involving an alleged assault of two college aged females on Friday, April 9, 2010.

At approximately 10:30PM two females were assaulted on campus in the area of Duke Dr. by another group of females.

The victims were treated and released from RMH for non-life threatening injuries.

One of the suspects is described as a tall thin Hispanic or African American female wearing a black jacket and jeans.

The case is still being actively investigated by law enforcement.
