What will eBenefits do for me?

- ❖ Level 1:
 - ❖ Locate a VA / DOD Facility
 - ❖ Apply and Obtain Home Loan Certificate of Eligibility
 - ❖ Request State Benefits Information
- ❖ Level 2:
 - ❖ Access and Retrieve Copies of Official Military Personnel Records (e.g. DD-214)
 - ❖ Generate Letters – Service Verification, Civil Service Preference, etc.
 - ❖ Check Status of Compensation and Pension Claims
 - ❖ View Payment History of VA Benefits
 - ❖ Transfer of Education Benefits for Post 9/11 GI Bill
 - ❖ Check Appeal Status

How do I enroll in eBenefits?

When you join the military, or while you're still in the military, enroll with your Common Access Card (CAC).

- ❖ Level 1 – Apply online at www.eBenefits.va.gov
- ❖ Level 2 –
 - ❖ Veterans: Visit a VA facility & verify your identity in person
 - ❖ Veterans in receipt of benefits from VBA via direct deposit: Call 1-800-827-1000
 - ❖ Service Members & Family: Use your CAC
 - ❖ Retirees: Use your MyPay account
 - ❖ Veterans (DoD employees or contractors): Use your CAC
