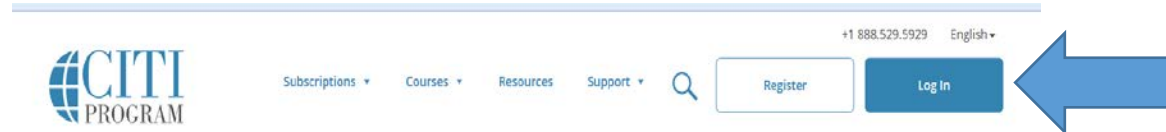


Using Single Sign On (SSO) for CITI Program training

Go to CITI Program's website and click on "Log in":


