JMU Recycling has greatly expanded its capabilities in support of your efforts.

ALL OF THESE CAN BE PUT IN A DESKSIDE BIN:

- **White Paper** (The White Paper can have any Color Ink on it)
- **Mixed Paper:** Colored Paper, Newspaper, Magazines, Paperboard, Catalogs, Sticky Notes, and Envelopes (Including those with windows)
- Small amounts of **Corrugated Cardboard** and **CLEAN Pizza Boxes**
- **Plastic #1 and #2 ONLY** of any color
- **Glass Bottles** of any color
- **Aluminum, Tin and Steel Containers**
- **Plastic Film:** Plastic Grocery Bags, Sandwich Bags and Bubble Wrap
- **Batteries (All)**
- **Toner and Print Cartridges** in Grocery Bags (Paper or Plastic) or their original box

Deskside bins may only be placed in offices, not common areas. For information on recycling bins for common areas, lounges, etc., please call 568-6074. **NO** more than five total food and beverage containers in a deskside bin. Food residue, liquids and trash contaminate the recycling. Contaminated bins cannot be collected!

ITEMS THAT CAN BE PICKED UP BY CALLING 568-6074:

- **Large Amounts of Cardboard**
- **Electronics Waste**
- **Metal Products**
- **Wire**
- **Wood and Wood Products**
- **CFLs**

After the recycling has been collected, it is then taken to JMU's off-campus recycling warehouse where it is sorted by hand.

NONE OF THESE CAN BE PUT IN A DESKSIDE BIN:

- **Plastics #3 - #7**
- **Used Tissues**
- **Used Paper Towels**
- **Transparencies**
- **Wet Paper**
- **Styrofoam Cups or Packaging**
- **Candy Wrappers**
- **Waxed Paper, Waxed Cups, or Cartons**
- **DIRTY Pizza Boxes**
