What in the world impacts you on a daily basis? Send us your scripts by February 2, 2020. Once submitted, a jury of JMU student readers will select four scripts for a public reading. Each play will be assigned a student director and actors from the JMU School of Theatre and Dance in preparation for a reading at the Theatre in Our Schools conference on April 18, 2020!

We welcome scripts representing a range of global perspectives of race, culture, language, disability, gender, nationality, and political worldview.

PLEASE READ SUBMISSION POLICY CAREFULLY:

- Electronic script submissions, in standard Samuel French playwriting format 12-point font, character name centered or 3.5 inches from left margin, 1" margin all around should be emailed to: <u>whatintheworldjmu@gmail.com</u> Remove all playwright identification from the actual script (this includes name, address, e-mail, or phone).
- 2. In the body of the email include: Script Name, Your Name and Email, Name of your High School, and the Name and E-mail of Mentor/Teacher. Then, attach your script.
- 3. Scripts should not be no more than ten pages long, not including your title page and page for setting, time and character.
- 4. Only one submission per student will be accepted. Scripts will not be returned.
- 5. To be considered, scripts must be **received** by 11:59pm Eastern Standard Time **February 2, 2020**.
- 6. If your play is selected, you will be notified, via email, by March 1, 2020. If you do not hear from us, your play was not selected.
