Advising Notes for Hospitality Management

- It is important for students intending to transfer for HM to start working on the required 600 hours of related work experience **before** transferring to JMU. This is a pre-requisite to one of the HM junior year courses. Approved businesses and industries that will meet this requirement are hotels, motels, catering companies, restaurants, food services for college dining halls, resorts, travel companies, airlines, cruise ship lines and event management companies. Students can provide copies of pay stubs or a memo from their supervisor documenting the number of hours worked.
- Hospitality Management is a Bachelor of Science degree; two math courses are required.
- ACTG 244, Accounting for Non-Business majors, is required. There is no equivalent at BRCC, but students
 may take **both** ACC 211 and ACC 212 as two of their approved electives, and that will waive ACTG 244 once
 they get to JMU.
- Students may take BUS 240 as one of their approved electives. This will take the place of HM 203 at JMU.
- HM majors also earn a minor in General Business.
- Differential tuition for College of Business majors/minors: Students will be charged an additional \$50 per credit for all College of Business courses (with the exception of ECON 200). See <u>Differential Tuition</u> for more information.
