

Workplace Readiness Skills for the Commonwealth Grades 3 – 5 School

Personal Qualities and People Skills

1. **Positive Work Ethic:** Comes to work every day on time, is willing to take direction, and is motivated to accomplish the task at hand

Objective: The student will arrive to his/her resource classes on time with the necessary material.

Activities:

1. The special education teacher will discuss the importance of arriving on time with necessary materials for the student. The teacher and student will complete one or more of the following:

- A. Teacher will read a story about the importance of being on time. See resource below.
- B. Brainstorm first, then role play in class what would happen if you are late to class.
- C. Brainstorm rewards that students would like for being on time (e.g. party/foods/field trips).
- D. Create video showing student being successful and another not being successful and talk about the difference.
- E. Teacher will set up a check list/behavior chart with student to reinforce on-time behavior. The teacher will check and reward accordingly.
