Day Three

June 18th - Eligibility, Decision Making, and Evidence Based Practice for SLPs

Speech Language Pathologists often serve as meeting facilitators in decision making processes. Participants will review techniques to decrease conflict, increase understanding, and build consensus during meetings. Criteria for eligibility and use of assessment information will also be discussed. Strategies to reduce over-identification and disproportionality in special education, and techniques to ensure appropriate use of assessment scores, observations, and classroom data will be shared.

Evidenced Based Practice (EBP) as it relates to students with speech language impairments will be reviewed. Discussion and activities that involve the EBP cycle, formulating a PICO question, reviewing research, and using of clinical data for decision making will be presented.
