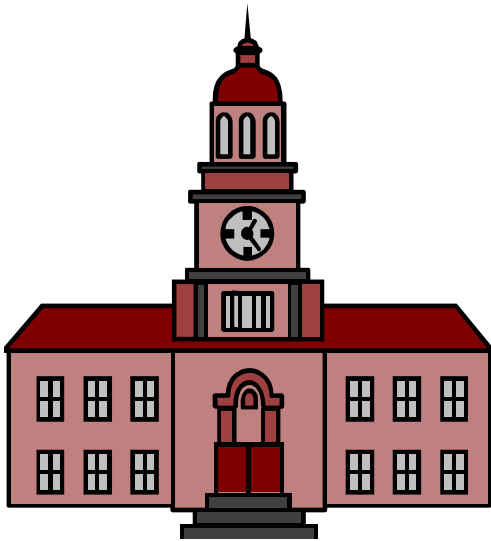

9:00 am – welcome, introduction and continental breakfast

High school students and their teachers will be welcomed to campus by college students. There will be a short icebreaker game for students to become acquainted. The high school students will hear a short presentation about life at college to gain a better understanding of what it is like to attend a post-secondary institution.

– attend a college class

Students will attend a class that will be taught by a college professor. When the class is over the students will travel to the dining hall or designated room for lunch with college students.

– lunch; campus exploration

Students will have time to eat lunch at the dining hall or a designated room and explore campus. Lunch will be free to all participants. College students will accompany the high school students to lunch and on the tour.

– Q&A session with students and Office of Disability Services (ODS) personnel

Everyone will meet again to hear information from ODS about what a student needs to do when applying to or attending college. Then the college students will answer questions and offer suggestions that may help.
