What is JMU Lifelong Learning?

The JMU Lifelong Learning Institute (LLI) is a membership-based program dedicated to enriching the intellectual and social lives of adult learners. We offer affordable online educational programs and opportunities for social interaction. Members serve as volunteers and peer-elected officers who help make decisions on behalf of the program.

What kind of courses does LLI offer?

LLI offers intellectually-stimulating, non-credit courses across a variety of disciplines.

Classes are designed to broaden understanding of diverse cultural, scientific, societal, and global issues.

Classes are vetted and organized by a member-led Curriculum Committee. New courses are added each semester.

How long are courses?

Most of our short courses conclude within five weeks. Classes meet once per week for either 90 or 120 minutes. Course descriptions indicate the number of sessions and list all meeting dates and times.

Who leads instruction?

LLI faculty include expert guest lecturers and other highly-qualified instructors, many of whom are current or retired university faculty. Several community leaders, business owners, and artists also teach in the program.

Where are classes held?

To protect the health of our learning community during COVID-19, we have transitioned to 100% online learning. All classes are delivered through Zoom. This enables members to stay safe, healthy, and connected from home. We provide free Zoom training upon request.

What are the requirements to participate?

Membership is open to everyone. LLI students are self-motivated learners who embrace the joy of learning—without exams and grades—and are curious about the world.

Although we host free public lectures, most classes and events require active membership in the program. Annual membership fees are waived through June 30, 2021. Take advantage of this limited-time offer by joining today!

What is the difference between membership and course fees?

As a self-sustaining program, our annual budget is based on the membership and program fees that students pay.

Membership fees are annual dues that help offset operating costs and must be renewed each year. The membership year runs from July 1 – June 30. An active membership is required to register for courses and events.

To promote wider access to adult education during COVID-19, **we have waived all membership fees through June 30, 2021.**

Course fees refer to the registration cost for each class. This fee varies based on the number and length of class meetings. The average course cost for 2020-21 is \$40.
