Charge: The A-Dean Working Group (ADWG) is charged with providing faculty members working at the A-dean level the opportunity to share knowledge, collaborate to develop effective strategies for college/unit-assigned activities, and provide feedback to academic leadership on problems and emerging issues.

The A-Dean Working Group will:

- 1. Foster peer-to-peer learning and strengthen relationships across colleges/units through regular meetings and collaborative problem exploration
- 2. Explore challenging division-wide problems and emerging issues identified by the deans, vice provosts, and provost to provide possible solutions

Summary of Current Semester Activity:

- The working group was assembled and given their charge on March 22, 2022. The cochairs then met on Friday, March 25, 2022 for an initial planning session, followed up by meetings with Jennifer Campfield (March 29, 2022) and Melinda Wood (April 6, 2022).
- On April 13, 2022 (3:30-4:30), the working group had their first meeting and met with Melinda Wood to explore the mission/vision of CHOICES particularly the balance between the university focus and college/unit focus and to look ahead at larger questions: *How can Admissions and Colleges/Units better coordinate communication and outreach to admitted students? What are the challenges that need to be addressed? What are the opportunities, moving forward?*

• One of the action items from the April 13, 2022 meeting was to solicit members from the working group to form an admissions-focused sub-group who would work with Melinda. The co-chairs asked members of the group to identify if admissions/recruitment was a part of their role and, if so, to indicate if they were willing to serve on this subgroup. Also, the co-chairs invited members to go back to their colleges to verify who would be the best person for this role (if not them). Ultimately, the co-chairs wanted to make sure that the admissions subgroup is bringing the right people together for this important work.

Future Work Planned:

- The working group has a meeting scheduled for May 25, 2022 (12-1) at which time we plan to discuss how we want to move forward as a working group including our scheduling for summer, and our fall work structure.
- The co-chairs hope to meet with Jennifer Campfield and Elizabeth Oldmixon in early June to talk about the goals of the VPFCP and to schedule a meet and greet with Elizabeth and the A Dean Working Group in the summer. We envision this as more of a social event than a working meeting.
