Charge: To evaluate and select student and alumni nominees for fellowship, scholarship, and award competitions requiring JMU nomination, and to contribute to the growth of the Office of Fellowships and Awards (OFA).

Summary of Current Semester Activity:

- The Fall semester is the busiest semester for this committee, including multiple meetings, as evidenced in the Fall 2021 report.
- In Spring 2022, the FNC broke into subcommittees to interview four Boren candidates with 2-3 interviewers on each panel at the end of January.
- Per Boren guidelines, all Boren candidates are nominated (similar to Fulbright), but the
 interview is a required component of the application. Feedback was provided to each
 candidate in the interview session.
- In February, all FNC members received the application from our one Udall candidate this
 year. FNC members completed an evaluation of the application and made
 recommendations; the Udall candidate was nominated with feedback from the
 committee members for application improvement.
- FNC members also suggested ways to enhance interactions with the Office of Fellowships and Awards. These suggestions are being reviewed and implemented.

Future Work:

• The committee will meet very early in the Fall 2022 semester to evaluate Rhodes, Marshall, Mitchell and Knight-Hennessy applicants. Fall 2022 is expected to again be a busy semester as the Office of Fellowships and Awards has expanded, adding a second advisor, with a focus on reaching as many students and alumni as possible.
