Summary of Current Semester Activity

Meeting: December 11, 2022

The Fellowships Nomination Committee (FNC) met on Zoom on December 11, 2022 at 10:15 AM for its first meeting of AY 2022-2023. Our goal was to review our two Gaither Junior Fellows Program and two Truman Fellowship applications. We began with a brief discussion of each of the Gaither nominees, followed by a review of the Truman candidates, including strengths and weaknesses of all candidates. Following discussion, we reached consensus on nominating all candidates with significant revisions to their current application drafts. The FNC provided responses, reactions, and feedback to Meredith Malburne-Wade to share with the candidates.
