- 2. To assess and provide recommendations pertaining to instructional faculty recruitment, detailed in the existing 2021 AA Guidelines for Recruiting and Hiring Faculty, from the creation of a job announcement to the point of offer.
- 3. To advise the provost on matters concerning faculty recruitment during the 2022-23 academic year.

Summary of Current Semester (Spring 2022) Activity:

- A Team's Channel was created to hold various documents for taskforce members to review relating to the history of faculty recruitment guidelines and other relevant documents.
