



R.N.-B.S.N. Memorandum of Agreement between James Madison University and Piedmont Virginia Community College

The James Madison University Department of Nursing proposes a Memorandum of Agreement designed to expand the number of baccalaureate-prepared nurses to serve the Commonwealth.

The program is open to students who wish to pursue the JMU B.S.N. degree. Students must complete the Associate of Applied Science degree in Nursing at PVCC and then transfer to JMU.

Attached are two documents that delineate the plan for implementing the R.N.-B.S.N. Memorandum of Agreement between James Madison University and Piedmont Virginia Community College. These documents include the:

- Intent Form, which is completed by the student and his/her PVCC adviser and provides the information that will allow JMU to track the student's progress. It also spells out the conditions of the Memorandum of Agreement for the student.
- Curriculum Outline and Advising Guide, which specifies the courses that the student will take at PVCC to transfer to JMU, thus ensuring that the basic level of requirements for the major are met before the student enrolls at JMU.

The agreement will be implemented beginning in fall 2018 with the first students transferring to JMU in the spring 2019.

Under this memorandum, all parties will annually review program curriculum and enrollment patterns and procedures beginning in fall 2019 and revise them as appropriate.

Note: This document is only a guide; students wishing to transfer to JMU under the R.N.-B.S.N. Program Memorandum of Agreement must also sign an official Letter of Intent.

JMU requires that students earn a minimum of 120 credit hours to graduate. Of the 120 credit hours, students must earn a minimum of 60 credit hours at a four-year institution and a minimum 30 credit hours at JMU.

Application deadlines for fall and spring admission to the JMU R.N.-B.S.N. program are posted on the JMU R.N.-B.S.N. website (http://nursing.imu.edu/rntobsn/index.html).
