Education Highlights

- Future teachers are placed in more than 1,600 clinical settings spanning more than 28 different school divisions, accounting for over 263,000 hours of school-based field engagement.
- 95% of principals surveyed indicate that new teachers from JMU "have a positive impact on students through effective teaching."
- JMU is a leader in Virginia for educational leadership with more than 200 practicing educators enrolled in cohorts throughout 13 different counties to prepare for school administrator licensure.
