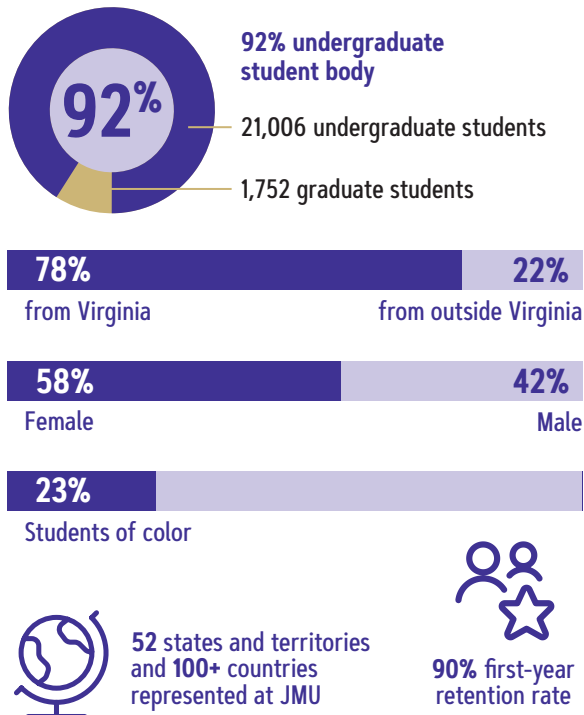
## Harrisonburg, Virginia Public, four-year institution

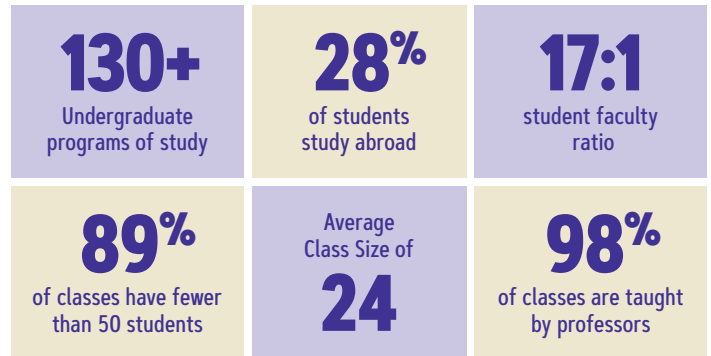

### First-Year Admissions

#### Two Required Steps

**1 Application** - Apply online at [jmu.edu/applynow](https://jmu.edu/applynow)

**2 Transcripts** - Official high school transcripts and senior year schedule must be sent by the application deadline.

#### Optional Information

- One letter of recommendation
- Personal essay
- Standardized test scores  
(18% of applicants submitted in 2023-24)
  - SAT mid-50% range: 1210-1370
  - ACT mid-50% range: 26-31

#### What We Look For

Admission to JMU is competitive and strong applicants are selected based on the following criteria:

- **Core academic courses:** English, social science, foreign language, lab science and mathematics\*
- **Grades:** Mostly A's and B's in core academic classes
- **Rigor of course work:** Honors, AP, IB, Dual Enrollment and Cambridge International

Other things considered include involvement in extracurricular activities and additional information found in the letter of recommendation and in the personal essay.

Students can earn college credit for AP, IB, DE and CI courses taken in high school.
