#### How to Get Back and Forth from JMU's Campus

In the heart of Virginia's picturesque Shenandoah Valley, JMU is within reach of several reasonably priced options to help you get home and back to campus.

We have your travel needs covered! From our regional airport, to shuttle and limousine services and charter buses, there are multiple ways to get you where you need to go. Many options provide easy transportation to major Washington, D.C. and Richmond airports and train stations.

#### **Bus Services**

The Virginia Breeze provides daily coach bus service from JMU to the Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD) and Amtrak's Union Station in Washington, D.C. The bus departs from JMU at Godwin Hall. Tickets may be purchased online at *www.virginiabreeze.org*.

**CollegeTransit** operates during the Thanksgiving, Winter and Spring breaks and services cities in Maryland, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and New York. Visit **CollegeTransit.com** for schedule information and reservations.

#### Shuttle Services

JMU Shuttle service provides safe, convenient and comfortable transportation that is operated by professional and courteous drivers. It is a service designed as a resource to help towards meeting the travel needs of our university students during the Thanksgiving, Winter and Spring Breaks. The JMU Transportation Department will provide shuttle service between JMU and the Charlottesville area on the last day of classes and also on the day prior to classes resuming around these breaks.

SDH Shuttle is one of many first-rate amenities that provides transportation between JMU campus and the Shenandoah Valley Airport. Services must be booked at least 48 hours before your scheduled flight. Rates for SDH Shuttles are \$50 one-way or \$70 round-trip within immediate service areas of Harrisonburg, Staunton, and Waynesboro.
