We have had an absolute blast getting back on the road this year and getting to see many of you and your students in person! With our fall recruitment travel winding down, we wanted to share some data with you from our very productive season.

Between both in-person and virtual travel, our team attended 144 college fairs, completed 518 high school visits, hosted multiple receptions, and participated on several panels. In total, we saw 4,245 students over the last three months!

Most majors within the College of Visual and Performing Arts have additional application requirements. These include a portfolio review or audition, personal interview, and letters of recommendation. We require students to apply for undergraduate admission prior to applying to the College of Visual and Performing Arts. Students wishing to pursue these majors must be admitted to both the university and their desired program. It is possible that a student will be admitted to JMU but not into a visual or performing arts program.
