APPLICATION UPDATES:

After receiving feedback from you and your students last year, we are excited to share a few changes with you as we enter our second year on the Common Application. Please reach out to counselored@jmu.edu or your assigned regional admissions counselor with any questions.



Common Application:

- Personal Essay:
 - James Madison University now accepts the Common Application Personal Essay as our
 optional personal statement. Applicants can choose from any of the seven prompts and
 can write up to 650 words. When submitting their JMU application, students are presented
 the opportunity to decide whether they want JMU to receive their Personal Essay. We will
 also continue to accept responses submitted in the Additional Information and COVID-19
 Impact sections.
- Activities:
 - We will now be accepting up to ten activities to be submitted as a part of a student's application. This change applies to both the Common Application and our own JMU ApplyWeb Application. Extra-curricular involvements remain an optional portion of a student's JMU application.

<u>Discontinuation of Coalition Application Membership:</u>

With less than 2% of our applicants last year applying via the Coalition Application, JMU has discontinued our membership on that platform. We found that the overwhelming majority of our applicants applied via the Common Application (95%), and we also continue to offer our own JMU ApplyWeb Application as an alternative for interested students.

Counselor's Companion Discontinued:

After fifteen years of service, James Madison University's Office of Admissions has discontinued our Counselor's Companion tool. With applicants having access to their Applicant Center account in MyMadison and bringing on the Common Application, we feel it is no longer necessary to continue with these services. Our process only requires two things: a completed application and an official high school transcript. If an application is incomplete, it is the high school transcript that is missing. New Carnegie Classification:

JMU's world-class academic excellence and national prominence were validated with a new Carnegie Classification status of **R2 Doctoral University** with high research activity through the Carnegie Commission.

We received and accepted an invitation to join the Sun Belt Conference, moving JMU to the Football Bowl Subdivision and the highest level in D-1 athletics. Ahead of our first contest (September 3rd) as a member of the Sun Belt Conference, James Madison Athletics had surpassed its previous football season ticket record with 7,582 tickets sold and counting.

CAMPUS CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

Carrier Library:

- The Commonwealth of Virginia recently approved funding for a major renovation and expansion of Carrier Library. This support will help us create a more welcoming, safe, inclusive campus library with modernized systems, re-envisioned services, and inspiring spaces for teaching, learning, research, and expert consultation. The renovated building will also include space for the Furious Flower Poetry Center!
- Construction will begin in summer 2023. Carrier Library will remain open for the 2022-23 academic year. You might see some changes in the building this year, such as new locations for furniture or collections, as we prepare for renovation. The building will then close for construction, which will likely begin soon after graduation festivities in May 2023.
- Carrier Library is anticipated to re-open in Fall 2026, following the successful completion of this major renovation and expansion.

The Convocation Center:

 Construction began in March on a renovation of the JMU Convocation Center. Previously the home of JMU basketball, the building will be transformed into a competition venue for volleyball; enhanced indoor training space for track & field; and locker rooms, offices, sports medicine and more for multiple other sport programs.

Sentara Park:

- James Madison Athletics has recently completed construction on an expansion at Sentara Park, the home of JMU lacrosse, men's soccer, women's soccer, track and field and cross country.
- The project features construction of a pair of stand-alone buildings bookending the main grandstand. Building one encompasses 2,400 square feet and includes a visiting team locker room, showers and restroom as well as a concessions area for guests and needed storage space for Athletics. Building two includes a locker room, coaches meeting room, showers and restroom for the home team as well as a sports medicine suite.
