## Dining Services

## Meal Plans

Students living in university residence halls are required to purchase one of three residential meal plans. Many off-campus students also choose to purchase an on-campus meal plan that fits their schedule. Most meal plans are a combination of Punches and Dining Dollars that students can use at any dining facility on campus.

- **Meal Punches:** A punch can be used as entry into any all-you-care-to-eat dining halls or towards a meal at most a-la-carte locations. Students can choose a meal plan with a set number of punches per week.
- **Dining Dollars:** A declining balance of funds included in a meal plan that can be used at any dining facility as well as vending machines throughout campus. The amount of dining dollars available depends on the selected meal plan. Additional money can be added as needed.

14 meal punches per week Sunday – Saturday  
\$275 in Dining Dollars  
7 guest meals per semester

### **All Access**

Unlimited punches to D-Hall and E-hall  
\$200 in Dining Dollars  
12 guest meals per semester  
2 punches per day to use for Duke Deals and equivalency punches

### **All Access Plus**

Unlimited punches to D-Hall and E-hall  
\$400 in Dining Dollars  
12 guest meals per semester  
3 punches per day to use for Duke Deals and equivalency punches

## Off-Campus Meal Plans

### **10 Punch Plan**

10 meal punches per week, Sunday – Saturday  
\$275 in Dining Dollars  
5 guest meals per semester

### **14 Punch Plan**

14 meal punches per week, Sunday – Saturday  
\$275 in Dining Dollars  
7 guest meals per semester

### **Block 50 Plan**

50 punches per semester  
\$250 in Dining Dollars
