Information technology is an essential element of academic life, enabling study, research and personal communication. As a means to excellence in achieving its education, research and service missions, the University provides and supports computing and electronic communication services for all its students.

Student Computer Labs

More than 500 Windows and Macintosh computers are available in student labs scattered throughout campus. The labs offer a variety of word processing, spreadsheet, graphic, presentation and statistical software. There are two labs open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

JMU's on-campus student network gives students high-speed access to email, the Internet and other network resources throughout campus. Wireless access is available in all academic locations including residence halls.
