The Arboretum is a tree, wildflower, and wildlife preserve. Please help us in being good stewards of the Arboretum!

Respect & protect the Arboretum wildlife:

- Leashed dogs are welcome! Courtesy bags are located at both of our welcome boards. Please discard bag(s) in trash cans.
- **Please do not feed the ducks.** The Arboretum's pond habitat can support only a small number of ducks. When they rely on food from the public, they overpopulate and deteriorate the pond's health.
- Fishing is prohibited.

Maintain the peace, beauty & health of the Arboretum:

- Discard all waste in appropriate receptacle.
- No flames anywhere in the Arboretum, including grilling fires.
- Extinguish cigarettes, discarding cold butts in the trash cans
- Stay out of the pond, streams, and other water features.
- Use biodegradable confetti rather than glitter or other nonbiodegradable materials.
- Do not remove any natural or man-made materials from the Arboretum (flower picking, plant or wood removal)
- Group sports on the lawn are prohibited.
- No bicycles allowed on chipped trails.
