#### art courses

**6 credits** The six credits of studio art electives (300-400 level) must be taken in a single studio area. Graphic design and architectural design course credits cannot count as a concentration area. Art credits cannot be double-counted.



### art electives

**9 credits** A minimum of nine credit hours of general art electives must consist of studio-based courses with an ART prefix (excluding ART 200, ART 304, ART 305, ART 491, ART 493 and ART 496).

#### general art electives

**9 credits** The other nine credit hours of general art electives must consist of any courses with the prefix ARCD, ARED, ART, ARTH, GRPH and INDU.

## art history elective

**3 credits** 300-400 level Excludes ARTH 490, ARTH 495 and ARTH 499.
