- 4-VA at JMU Collaborative Research Awards 2024 Proposal Cycle 4-VA is seeking proposals for two
  types of collaborative research awards, which will be funded during the 2025 fiscal year (July 2025June 2026):
  - Research initiation awards, with budget requests of up to \$7,000, are intended to seed original research collaborations.
  - Research scale-up awards, of up to \$25,000, are intended to build additional capacity for
    promising research collaborations. To be considered for a scale-up award, applicants must have
    previously received a 4-VA research initiation award or must provide compelling evidence of
    their capacity to take existing research to the next level with intentions of pursuing significant
    external funding upon project completion.
