<a href="#">Expansion of Provisional Unlawful Presence Waivers of Inadmissibility</a>	<p><b>FINAL RULE</b> – Expands the class of individuals who may be eligible for a provisional waiver. The provisional waiver process is designed to encourage unlawfully present individuals to leave the US for consular processing of the immigrant visas, and return to the US legally to reunite with their US citizen or lawful permanent resident family members. <b>Effective Date: July 29, 2016</b></p>
<a href="#">Revision of OMB Circular No.-A-130 – Managing Information as a Strategic Resource</a>	<p><b>NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY</b> – Revisions reflect changes in the law and advances in technology, and emphasize the role of both privacy and security in the Federal information life cycle. <b>Effective Date: July 28, 2016</b></p>
<a href="#">Draft – National Best Practices for Sexual Assault Kits: A Multidisciplinary Approach</a>	<p><b>NOTICE</b> – Announces the opening of the public comment period for the DRAFT “National Best Practices for Sexual Assault Kits: A Multidisciplinary Approach”. <b>Comments due: September 2, 2016</b></p>
<a href="#">Truth in Lending – Regulation Z</a>	<p><b>PROPOSED RULE (OFFICIAL INTERPRETATIONS)</b> – Proposes requirement that the dollar threshold for exempt consumer credit transactions be adjusted annually by the annual percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical workers. <b>Comments due: September 6, 2016</b></p>
<a href="#">Amendment of ADA Title II and Title III Regulations to Implement ADA Amendments Act of 2008</a>	<p><b>FINAL RULE</b> – Adds new sections to Title II and III of the regulations to 1) revise the ADA definition of “disability” to ensure that it is broadly construed and applied without extensive analysis, and 2) make related changes required by the ADA Amendments Act in other sections of the regulations. <b>Effective Date: October 11, 2016</b></p>
<a href="#">Standards and Procedures for the Enforcement of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA)</a>	<p><b>NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING</b> – Proposes to revise regulations implementing a section of INA concerning unfair immigration-related employment practices. <b>Comments due: September 14, 2016</b></p>
<a href="#">Revision of the DOL FOIA Regulations</a>	<p><b>NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING</b> – Proposes to update and streamline the language of several FOIA procedural provisions, and incorporate changes brought about by FOIA under the OPEN Government Act of 2007 and the FOIA Improvement Act of 2016. <b>Comments due: October 17, 2016</b></p>
<a href="#">Request for Public Comment on the Proposed Changes to the NIH Guidelines for Human Stem Cell Research and the Proposed Scope of an NIH Steering Committee’s Consideration of Certain Human-Animal Chimera Research</a>	<p><b>NOTICE</b> – Requests public comment on 1) a proposal to amend Section IV and Section V of the NIH Guidelines for Human Stem Cell Research, and 2) the proposed scope of certain human-animal chimera research. <b>Comments due: September 6, 2016</b></p>
<a href="#">Notice and Recordkeeping for Use of Sound Recordings Under Statutory License; Technical Amendment</a>	<p><b>PROPOSED RULE</b> – Proposes amendment to regulations governing reporting requirements for noncommercial educational webcasters that pay no more than the minimum fee for their use of sound recordings under the applicable statutory licenses.</p>

<a href="#">Defining and Delimiting the Exemptions for Executive, Administrative, Professional, Outside Sales and Computer Employees</a>	<b>FINAL RULE</b> – Revises final regulations under the FLSA implementing the exemption from minimum wage and overtime pay for executive, administrative, professional, outside sales, and computer employees. <b>Effective Date: December 1, 2016</b>
<a href="#">Accessibility of User Interfaces, Video Programming Guides and Menus</a>	<b>FINAL RULE</b> – Announces OMB approval of information collection associated with the Commission’s <i>Second Report and Order</i> implementing provisions of the 21 <sup>st</sup> Century communications and Video Accessibility Act of 2010 related to accessible user interfaces and video programming ad guides. <b>Effective Date: December 18, 2016</b>
<a href="#">Closed Captioning of Video Programming; Telecommunications for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, Inc., Petition for Rulemaking</a>	<b>FINAL RULE</b> – Allocates the responsibilities of video programming distributors (VPDs) and video programmers with respect to the provision and quality of closed captions on television programming, with each entity responsible for closed captioning issues that are primarily within its control; amends the Commission’s captioning complaint procedures to include video programmers in the handling of complaints; and requires video programmers to register contact information and certify compliance with captioning obligations directly with the Commission. <b>Effective Date: September 22, 2016</b>
