<p>Veterans Affairs Proposes to Revise Collection of School Catalogs Prior to Approving a New Course, 81 Federal Register 69575, October 6, 2016</p>	<p>NOTICE – Accredited and non-accredited educational institutions, with the exception of elementary and secondary schools, must submit copies of their catalog to the State approving agency when applying for approval of a new course. State approving agencies use the catalog to determine what courses can be approved for VA training. The VA is announcing an opportunity for public comment on the collection of this information by the agency. Comments due: December 5, 2016</p>
<p>Proposed Rule on the Determination of Rates and Terms for Making and Distributing Phonorecords, 81 Federal Register 71657, October 18, 2016</p>	<p>PROPOSED RULE: Proposed rule regarding rates and terms applicable during the upcoming rate period for the section 115 statutory license for making and distributing phonorecords of nondramatic musical works. [EJB-e1]Comment Period Extended: November 17, 2016</p>
<p>Establishment of the Electronic Visa Update System, 81 Federal Register 72481, October 20, 2016</p>	<p>FINAL RULE: Amends the Department of Homeland Security’s regulations to establish the Electronic Visa Update System (EVUS). This system will allow for the collection of biographic and other information from nonimmigrant aliens who hold a passport issued with a nonimmigrant visa. Individuals subject to EVUS must periodically enroll in EVUS to retain the validity of their visas. EFFECTIVE DATE: October 20, 2016</p>

New Regulatory Requirements to Implement the Teacher Preparation Accountability System under HEA Title II, 81 Federal Register 75494, October 31, 2016	<p>FINAL RULE: Establishes new regulations to implement requirements for the teacher preparation accountability system under Title II of the HEA. The regulations address shortcomings in the current system by defining the indicators of quality that a State must use to assess the performance of its teacher preparation programs</p> <p>EFFECTIVE DATE: November 30, 2016</p>
Withholding of Unclassified Technical Data and Technology From Public Disclosure, 81 Federal Register 75352, October 31, 2016	<p>PROPOSED RULE: Proposed rule to establish policy, assign responsibilities and prescribe procedures for the dissemination and withholding of certain unclassified technical data and technology subject to ITAR and EAR. It applies to Dod components, their contractors and grantees and is meant to control the transfer of technical data and technology that could prove detrimental to the US.</p> <p>Comments due: December 30, 2016</p>
Technology Innovation – Personnel Exchanges, 81 Federal Register 73024, October 31, 2016	<p>FINAL RULE: This rule clarifies the appropriate use of Cooperative Research and Development Agreement authority by a Federal Laboratory for personnel exchanges where the Federal laboratory has an existing relationship with the potential partner through another legal mechanism as well as in the context of joint research projects and development of existing laboratory technology.</p> <p>EFFECTIVE DATE: November 23, 2016</p>

<p>Proposed Amendment to Regulation Governing the Accreditation of Prelicensure Registered Nursing Education Programs in Virginia, 33 Virginia Register Issue 4, October 17, 2016</p>	<p>NOTICE OF INTENDED REGULATORY ACTION: The proposed amendment would require all prelicensure registered nursing education programs in Virginia to have accreditation or candidacy status with a national accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education by the year 2020. <p>Petition to Amend Regulation Regarding Nursing Identification Badges, 33 Virginia Register Issue 4, October 17, 2016</p>	<p>INITIAL AGENCY NOTICE: Petition to replace the regulation requiring that nurses include first and last name on identification badges with a requirement for only first name and last initial. COMMENTS DUE: November 8, 2016</p>
