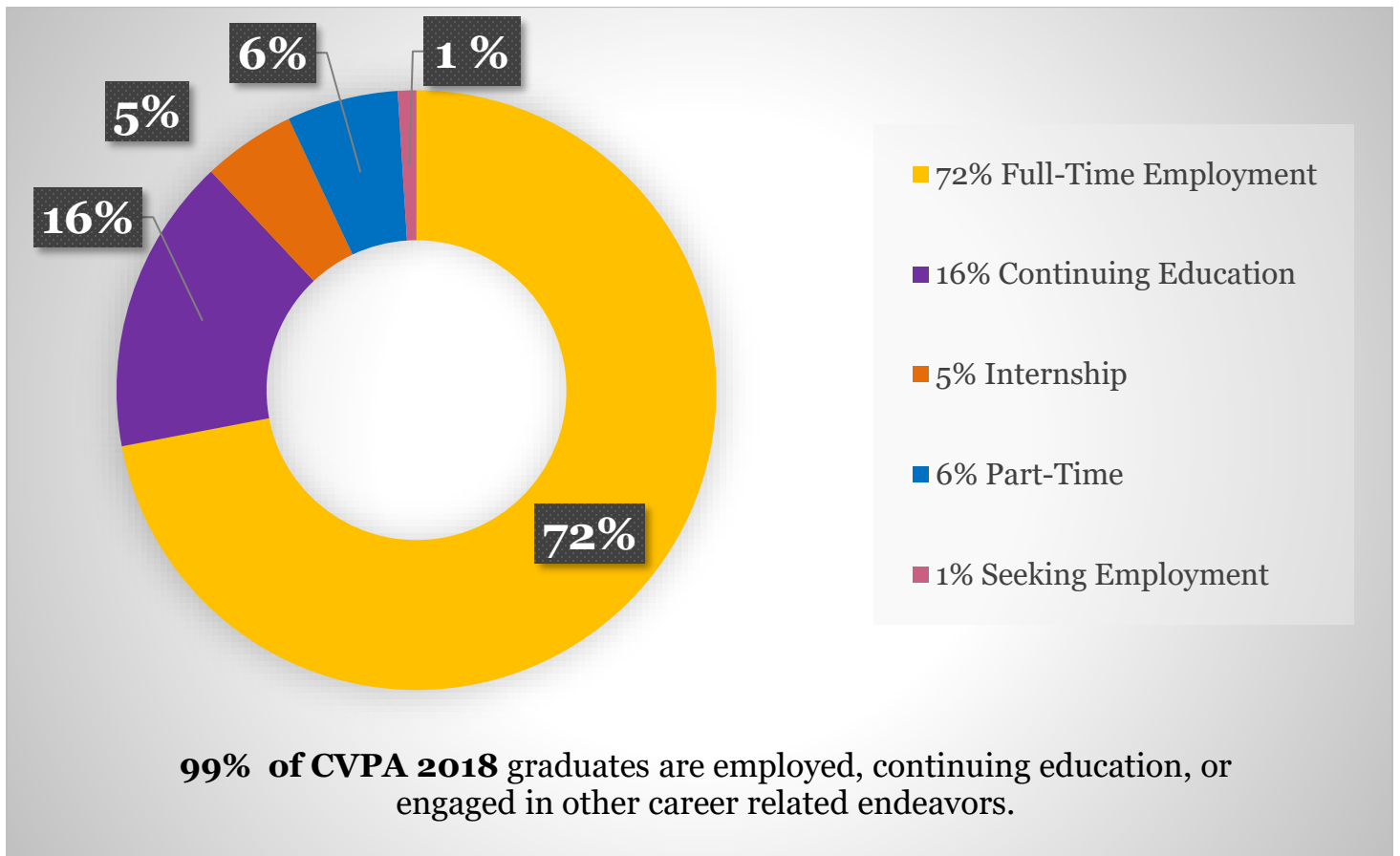
Career Outcomes: Class of 2018

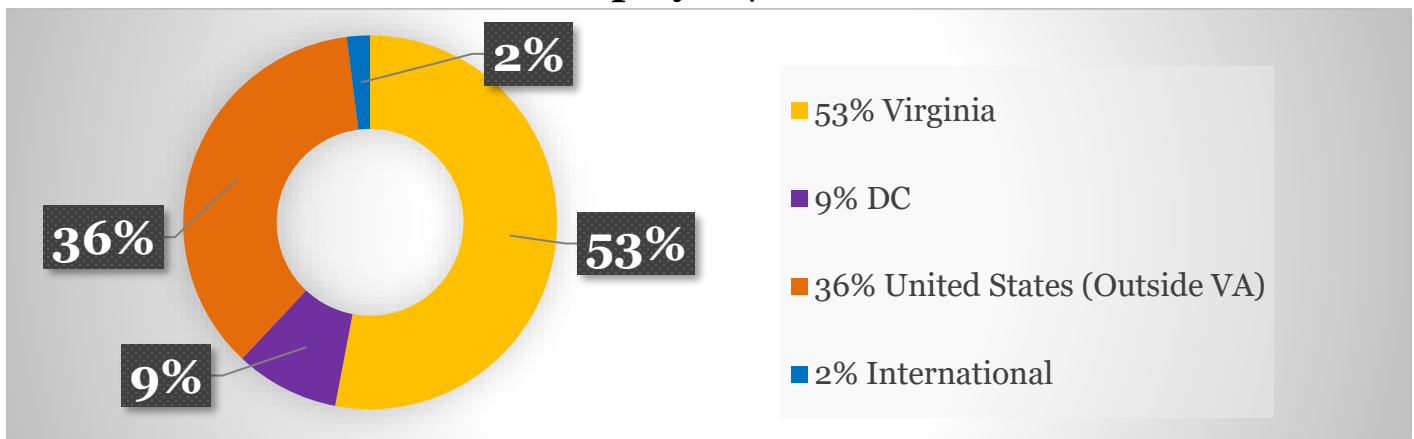
