Self-authorship: As a result of our programs, students will be able to both critically evaluate and propose strategies for deepening alignment between their beliefs and behaviors.

Civic Learning: As a result of our programs, students will be more capable of working effectively with others to address local, national, and global concerns by enhancing the following skills:

- capacity to communicate effectively;
- ability to take and explain diverse positions;
- ability to apply ethical reasoning skills;
- ability to critically analyze a contemporary problem;
- ability to effectively work across differences;
- ability to listen to a variety of perspectives on political issues

Cultural Humility: As a result of our programs, students will increase their cultural humility.

- Cultural humility: One's ability to maintain a stance that is open to others in relation to aspects
 of their cultural identity that are most important to them. It is part of a larger orientation
 emphasizing a "way of being" with those that are different from one self with particular
 sensitivity to the role cultural factors play in the lives of others. (Hook, Davis, Owen,

 - Openness to others
 - Self-awareness in relation to others
 - Understanding power imbalances
