Contracts for the 2002-2003 internship year totaled \$70,000. Contracts for the 2003-2004 internship year totaled \$78,000. Contracts for the 2004-2005 internship year totaled \$80,000. Contracts for the 2005-2006 year totaled \$85,000. Contracts for the 2006-2007 year totaled \$121,000, Contracts for the 2007-2008 internship year totaled \$103,000. Contracts for the 2008-2009 year totaled \$103,000. Although all students in the 2009-2010 cohort have secured internships, stipends will be distributed directly to intern by the internship site. Thus, these payments are no longer considered external funding as defined by the JMU Grants and Contracts and Sponsored Programs.
