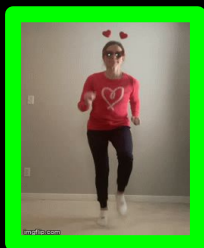


5 ski jumps then give 1 stick to the group to your left

5 mountain climbers then give 1 stick to the group to your right



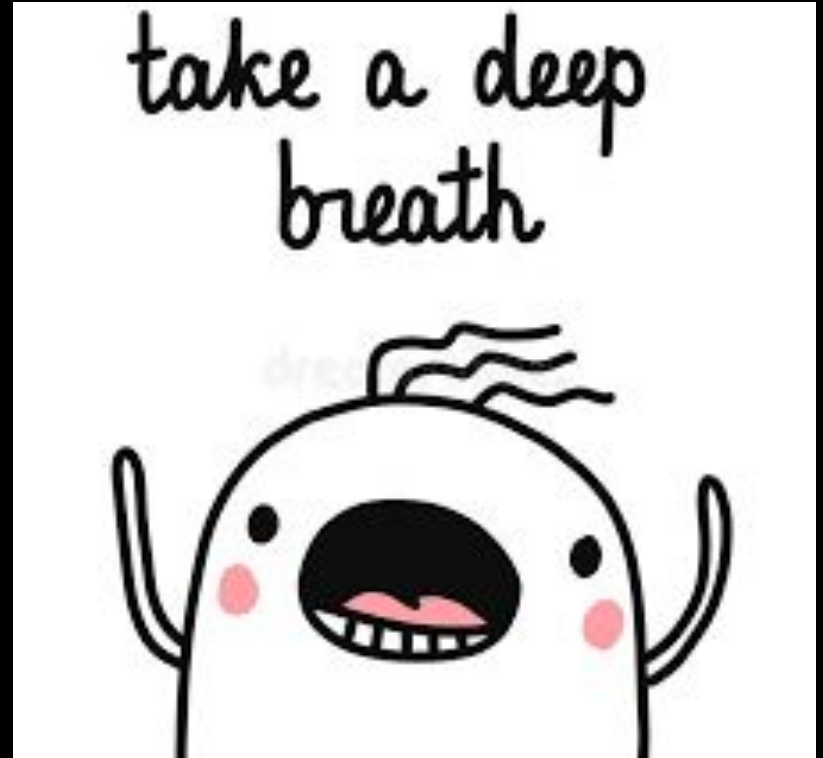
Jog 1 lap then grab a stick for your group



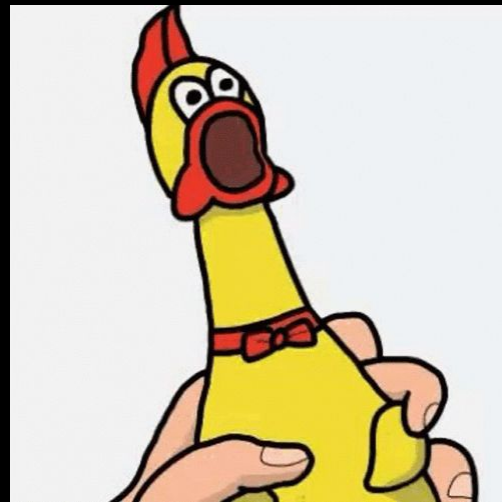
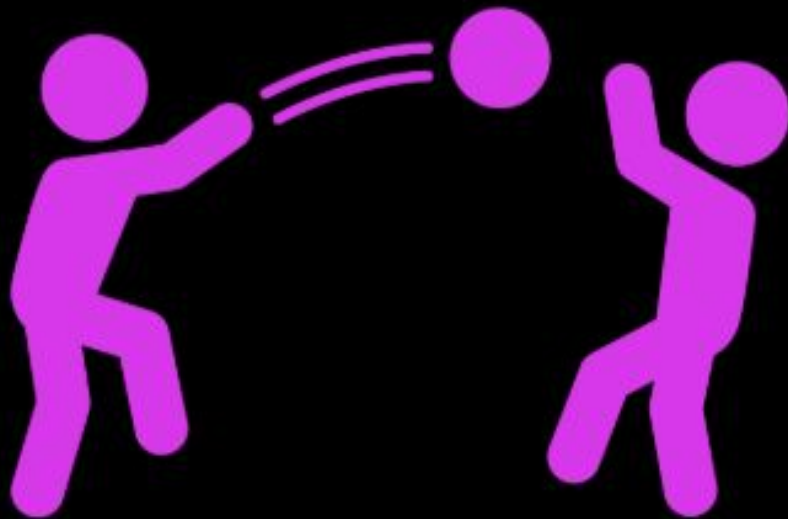
5 lunges then give 1 stick to any group

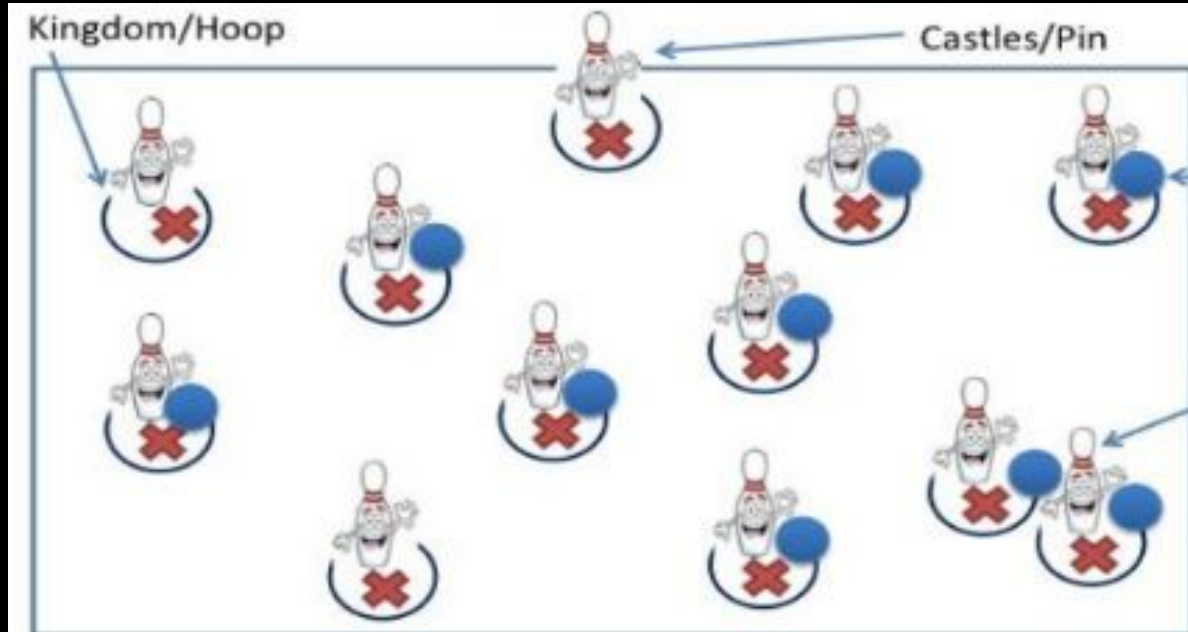
