Whereas, On October 1, 2019, The Student Government Association of James Madison University passed Senate Resolution 05 to encourage James Madison University to partner with Every Campus a Refuge and assist Church World Service, AND;

Whereas, The Student Government Association of JMU requested to actively collaborate in the implementation of the project, AND;

Whereas, The Refugee Task Force will be a group of students who will closely work with the Community Service-Learning Office to assist the refugee community in Harrisonburg, AND;

Whereas, The Refugee Task Force will provide transparency for this initiative that keeps the student body's interests in mind, AND;

Whereas, The Refugee Task Force will work to establish a strong connection with the local refugee population and to make a positive impact on the refugee crisis;

Now, therefore, be it Resolved by the Student Senate of James Madison University, That:
