Eligibility

Non-Competitive Admission

Students in good academic standing and who have declared one of the following majors are automatically eligible for the General Business Minor. Students in these majors do NOT need to submit an application prior to submitting a declaration in MyMadison.

- Chemistry
- Engineering

- Health Services Administration
- Hospitality Management
- Physics
- Sports and Recreation Management

Required Courses

The General Business Minor requires the completion of 18 credit hours of business coursework. These courses must be successfully completed with a minimum 2.0 grade point average to graduate with the General Business Minor. **Matriculated JMU students may take only one required course as transfer credit.** Students planning to take a course for transfer credit should follow the Office of the Registrar's transfer policy guidelines found at https://www.jmu.edu/registrar/students/transfer_credit.shtml.
