

WHICH SHOULD I CHOOSE?

This resource was created to assist students in making a decision between using the repeat forgive/repeat credit option. The statements below are meant to guide students in which option works best for their specific situation. Students are encouraged to talk to their advisor if they have questions.

REPEAT FORGIVE Only the second attempt of taking the course is used in the GPA calculation, but both grades remain on your transcript. Students only have two repeat forgive opportunities during their time at JMU.

REPEAT CREDIT Both attempts of taking the course are used in the GPA calculation, and both grades remain on your transcript.

Example	Option to Consider	Reason
I want to repeat a course needed for general education credit.	Repeat Credit	You may want to consider the repeat credit option if you did not receive an F in the course. Typically, students save their repeat forgive opportunities for major/minor courses.
I want to repeat a course needed for my major or minor.	Repeat Forgive	You may want to consider the repeat forgive option if you need a specific GPA to progress. To graduate you need a minimum of a 2.0 in the major and cumulative GPA.
I need to increase my GPA to be admitted into COB 300.	Repeat Forgive	You may want to consider repeat forgive if you have checked your BBA lower-level core classes in the BBA calculator, and you won't have the required 2.7 BBA GPA.
I am confident I can earn a higher grade by repeating the course.	Repeat Forgive or Repeat Credit	Each situation is different, and you will want to review the examples above to see which will make the higher impact.

MyMadison will default to repeat credit if you do not choose a repeat option. To select your repeat option go to MyMadison > Student Center > Enroll Classes > Edit > Choose Course.

You are able to select this yourself until the course adjustment deadline which can be found on the Registrar's website at www.jmu.edu/registrar. Students are ultimately responsible for selecting which option to use.
